What the law says about testing and tagging in Australia:

Each State and Territory is subject to OHS statute law and regulations. Compliance to Australian Standard AS/NZS 3760 is essential. There are obligations upon every business owner to ensure electrical safety in their workplace and to fulfill their duty of care to employees and customers. As a business owner if you do have an OHS obligation and do operate electrical equipment, then you must comply with the level identified in the standard. If not, enforcement penalties can apply and you may find your insurance is invalid.
